- 4. Read Proverbs 24:30-34. The writer says that "I looked and received instruction". What can we learn from this Proverb? John Ortberg says that when we are born each of us is given a "vineyard". God will help us work this vineyard but we have a choice to make in our part. What vineyards do you have in your life?
