1. The Shema says, "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. 5 You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might." Deut 6:4-5. Why is this the foundation of Judaism? What application does it have in our lives today?
2. Many followers of Christ compartmentalize God and their faith. What does it mean to compartmentalize God? What does that look like in real life?
3. Discuss the importance of linking God into our day to day conversations. What might this look like in your family?
4. Read Proverbs 24:30-34. The writer says that "I looked and received instruction". What can we learn from this Proverb? John Ortberg says that when we are born each of us is given a "vineyard". God will help us work this vineyard but we have a choice to make in our part. What vineyards do you have in your life?
