## **REFLECTION QUESTIONS**

If you are doing Forged & Refined, make sure to discuss at least one or two of these questions during your accountability time.

This month we have focused on the Gospel. God is our creator and we are accountable to Him. We were placed in a perfect garden, but humankind fell into sin so we were in desperate need. Fortunately, God sent his only Son, Jesus to rescue us when He died on the cross and rose again. We need to trust Him and allow these truths to impact our hearts and lives in a practical way.

- 1. We saw God's Plan of Salvation (GPS) as presented through the Roman's Road on Sunday. Romans 5:1 says we have peace with God because we are justified by Him and Romans 8:1 says we have no condemnation in Christ. What peace does your salvation bring to you as a believer? Do you have the peace of God?
- 2. Romans 8:38-39 says nothing is able to separate us from the love of Christ. How does God's love encourage you as a believer especially when you face difficult times in life or a sin struggle which you have trouble overcoming?
- 3. The good news of the Gospel is definitely for non-believers, but it's also for the believer every day! Out of the list of statements from Milton Vincent's *Gospel Primer, which* really stands out to you and why is that so?
  - The Gospel slays sin at the root and nullifies its power over me.
  - I never need to labor to gain or maintain my status before God.
  - On my worst days of sin and failure, the Gospel encourages me and that makes me more grateful to God.
  - When I realize the gift of God's love that's been given to me, I want to share the Gospel with others.
  - Pride in my own life is suffocated by the Gospel.
  - The Gospel gives me the ultimate prize: Life eternal with Jesus!
