REVIEW:

We are called to be holy in an unholy place and unholy time. 1 Corinthians 1:2 - *“To the church of God that is in Corinth, to those sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints together with all those who in every place call upon the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, both their Lord and ours.”*

QUESTIONS:

1. Do you desire to be holy, set apart and special to God or do you struggle with desiring holiness?
2. Ask yourself these questions to evaluate if you are striving for holiness:
 - Have I truly trusted Jesus as my Rescuer from sin?
 - Do I desire to worship God with other Christians and personally in my life? Do I have a desire to pray and talk to God?
 - Do I show love, a heart of service, and forgiveness to other people in the church and to non-believers?
 - Do I have the qualities of the fruit of the Spirit: *love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithful, gentleness and self control*?
 - Do I desire to deal with and confess sin in my life? Am I convicted of my sin?
 - Do I have a desire to learn God’s Word and apply it to your life?
 - Do I have a desire to share my faith with others?
3. As the church (and as small groups), how can we encourage others to strive for holiness?
