
## **MESSAGE RECAP & REFLECTION QUESTIONS**

1. Reuben (oldest son)	Unstable and Reckless "boiling waters"	*No one significant comes from his line.
2. Simeon	Violent / Cruel / Killers	Land divided to others
3. Levi	Violent / Cruel / Killers	Land divided to others  Descendants:  Aaron, Moses, Eli, Zacharias, John the Baptist
4. Judah	The Lion / The Ruler	Success: Line of the King & Messiah  Descendants: David and Jesus
5. Zebulun	Haven for Ships	Given significant land / trade routes
6. Issachar	Donkey	Given rich farm land Robust and hardy people
7. Dan	Judge / Serpent	Justice for God's people Lacked morality & idolatry  Descendant: Samson
8. Gad	Overcomer / Raiders	Harassed but find military success
9. Asher	Rich food	Best farmers Receives fertile coastal farm land
10. Naphtali	Doe	Other tribes would admire them
11. Joseph	Fruitful and strong (Growth and prosperity)	Two sons Ephraim and Manasseh receive the double blessing Descendants: Joshua, Gideon, Samuel
12. Benjamin	Wolf	Fierce and warlike Descendants: King Saul, Jonathan, Ehud, Esther and Paul
