Last week we began a series called Biblical Families. Our primary passage of study is from Psalm 128. The key to understanding this Psalm is found in the very first verse. "Blessed is everyone who fears the Lord, who walks in his ways!" The foundational principle for the entire Psalm is fearing the Lord.

- In what ways is the fear of God a motivating factor for you?
- In the sermon we talked about 4 ways to prepare "the soil" for a healthy and growing family. What are some changes that need to be made in your family to create a healthier environment for spiritual growth? How will you commit to these needed changes?
- What are some of the "weeds in the soil of your household" that need to be pulled?
