BIG PICTURE: UNLIKLEY HEROES - THE CHURCH

Jan 3	Peter	Movin' on up	Heroes grow in Christ
Jan 10	Paul	Run the race	Heroes never give up
Jan 17	Timothy	Just keep holding on	Heroes are faithful

Simple things you can do to reinforce the teaching:

DISCUSS the questions that appear on your child's activity sheet.

These questions can kick start discussion of the topic.

LEARN the BIG WORD bible verses with your child, even give a reward for remembering the verse!
